## **COUNSELORS CORNER- REPORT**

- I will be starting a “Be safe” program through the Red Cross with Mrs. Behrendt’s grade one class. The program content entails group discussions and activities around being safe, in particular safe from all forms of violence. Letters explaining the program will be sent home to parents.
- Our grade seven students will be receiving a suicide intervention presentation called, “Reaching Out”. This presentation is being put on through collaborative effort of the School District and Child and Adolescent Mental Health. A letter will be sent home as we near the determined presentation date. (Any grade eight students who did not receive this presentation last year will also receive the presentation later in February).
- I will be running a games club once again for students in grade 2-3. There will be a limit of 20 students. A main focus of the lunch games club will be to strengthen social skill development. The games club will run from January 16th – March 13th. (Every Monday). Memos will go home with students.
