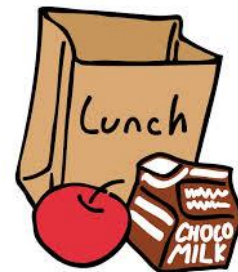

BW school has noticed an increase in the amount of children with head lice. As you all know it is very contagious therefore regular, routine head checks at home is recommended. The school will be doing a school wide check early next week and students with lice will be sent home for treatment. It is also very helpful when parents/caregivers report head lice cases to the school. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
